DEPARTMENT INVOLVED TRAFFIC ACCIDENT ON GREAT INAGUA

At approximately 1:15am on Sunday, 27th September, 2020, it was reported that a vehicular accident occurred on the Island of Great Inagua involving The Bahamas Department of Immigration's Jeep Wrangler **4524**, and a civilian vehicle resulting in serious injuries to the female civilian occupant/driver; however, the Immigration Officer was not seriously injured.

A silver five door foreign vehicle driven by the civilian female received extensive damages, while the Department's Jeep Wrangler received some damages.

Local medical teams and officers of the Royal Bahamas Police Force were reportedly on scene. Police and Senior Immigration Officials are enroute to Inagua to engage in further detailed investigations regarding this serious matter.

The Department's thoughts and prayers go out to the injured party and her family.
